Construction Users Roundtable (CURT)

The Mission of The Construction Users Roundtable is to promote cost effectiveness for owners doing business in the United States by providing aggressive leadership on issues that will significantly improve project engineering, maintenance and construction processes, thereby creating value for the owners.



CURT Owner Safety Awards

- Given annually to owners and contractors in several categories
- Award winners must meet strict criteria including minimum performance thresholds (e.g. no fatalities, TRIR < 1,0)
- Award winners must align with program criteria outlined in Construction Owners' Safety Blueprint (CURT document R-807, September 2004)



Owners' Safety Blueprint

Philosophy – It's up to the owners

Guiding Principles:

1. No injury or illness is acceptable
2. Owners should work to prevent all injuries
3. An organization will achieve whatever performance level it is willing to accept
4. ZERO incidents is the only justifiable goal

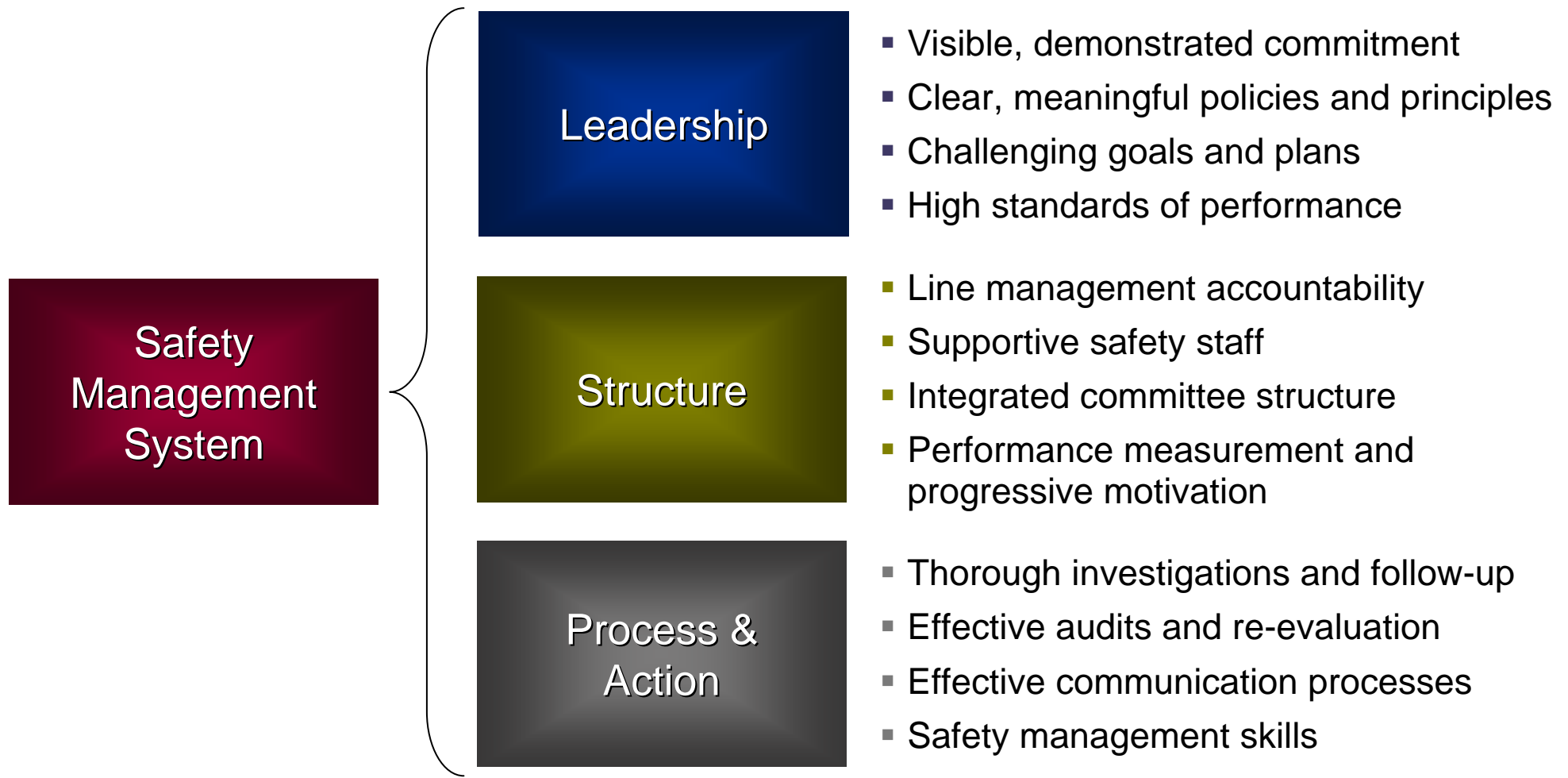




DuPont Success Factors

What are DuPont's Principles?

DuPont Safety Principles (S26G)

- All injuries and illnesses can be prevented.
- Management is responsible.
- All operating exposures can be controlled.
- Safety is a condition of employment.
- It is necessary to thoroughly train all employees to work safely.

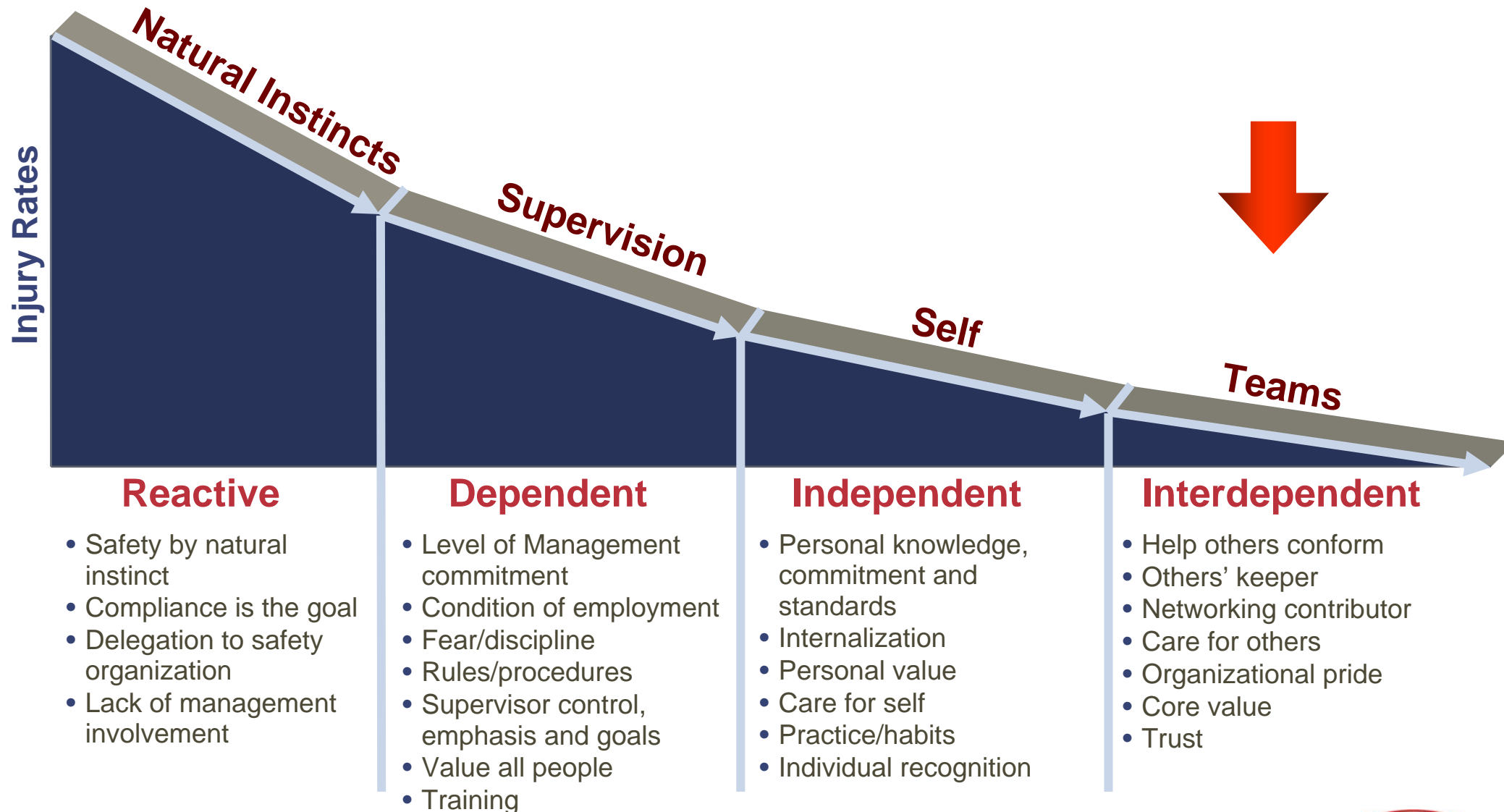


DuPont Safety Principles (S26G)

- Audits must be conducted.
- All deficiencies must be corrected promptly.
- People are the most important element of the Safety and Health program.
- Off-the-Job Safety is an important part of the safety effort.



We routinely assess our safety culture against the 12 elements and strive for the interdependent stage of development.



Felt Leadership

Visibility

- Proactive participation in safety activities

Principles

- Use Safety Principles to make decisions

Accessibility

- Open to discussion of safety issues with all employees

Communication

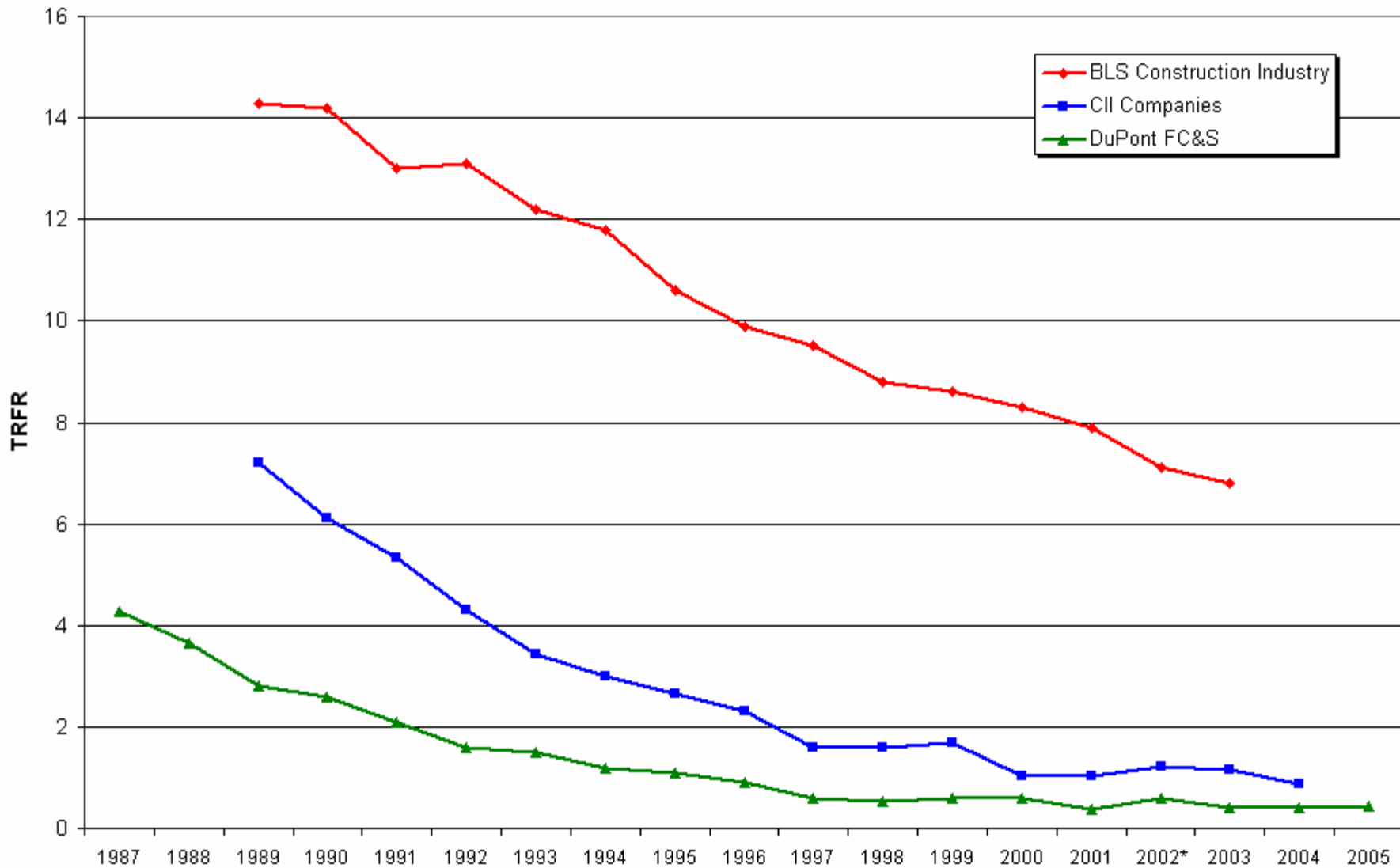
- Constant reinforcement of safety values
